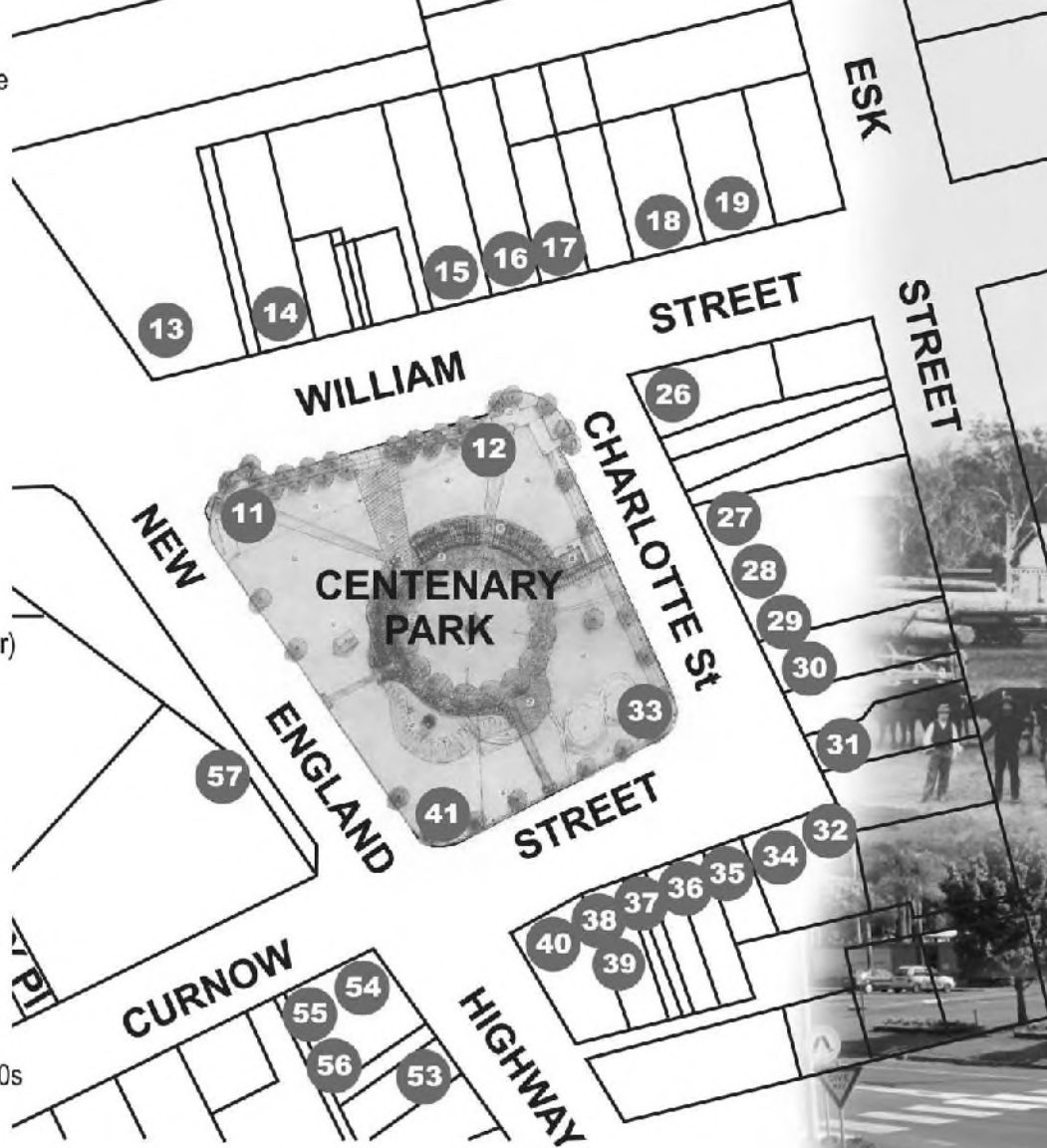

- 1. Carbethon Folk Museum, Historical Corner
- 2. Recreation Reserve, former showground
- 3. Site of Harrison's Sawmill, 1950 to 1963
- 4. Site of Blinco's Sawmill, and Blinco's Garage, first sawmill and first garage in Crows Nest
- 5. Uniting Church built 1905 - memorial wall
- 6. Site of first Council chambers
- 7. Concrete foundation of Littleton's Butcher Shop
- 8. Nolans' Building, 1917
- 9. Site of Commonwealth Hotel 1902 - 1941
- 10. Second Council Chambers est. 1940

- 20. Home of the family of John French VC
- 21. Site of McKirdy, blacksmith
- 22. Convent, 1917 to 1972
- 23. Catholic parish centre, formerly convent school
- 24. St Matthew's Catholic Church, built 1901, parish established 1916
- 25. Site of Co-operative Butter Factory 1903 to 1969

- 42. Site of Emmerson's sawmill and planing mill, 1908 to 1936, power station 1931 to 1948
- 43. 7 Nolan St was the hospital from 1929 to 1948
- 44. Presbyterian Church 1913 to 1946
- 45. Site of Mengel's welding works
- 46. Queensland's oldest continuous soft drink business
- 47. Soft drink factory, earlier location
- 48. Dr John Bourne Taylor's surgery and residence
- 49. Old Thornville School relocated
- 50. Oddfellows Hall - now a private residence
- 51. Bullocky's Rest, site of Crows Nest Run shepherd's hut
- 52. St Luke's Lutheran Church established 1926, building replaced 1969

- 58. Site of original Provisional, later State School from 1877 to 1959
- 59. Site of original St George's Anglican Church 1886 to 1958
- 60. Site of first house, Crows Nest Run, 1875
