













What makes a Motorcycle Friendly venue?

-  Signs, stickers, banners indicating that motorcyclists are welcome.
-  Designated parking within view of the venue. Parking on flat, level surface.
-  A welcoming greeting and casual atmosphere. Motorcycle related decor (vintage motorcycle on display, old helmets, fuel signs).
-  Spaces, shelves, coat hooks to place helmets, gloves, jackets and other rider apparel.
-  Brochures about riding routes.
-  Motorcycle magazines. Information about local motorcycle routes, fuel supplies, accommodation, visitor information centres and other motorcycle related tourist information.
-  Engaging conversation and banter.
-  Rider discounts or special deals/offers.
-  Accommodation venues and petrol sellers who offer a cleaning kit - suggested contents: chamois, Mr Sheen, chain lube, spray bottle with water.
-  A friendly farewell.
